With an increase of over 15,000 new employees since June of this year, the figures clearly demonstrate the importance of Construction to the Irish Economy.

According to the figures released from the Central Statistics Office, 12,300 of these new jobs were filled by Irish nationals, representing 81% of the new jobs, spread throughout the country.
