LIVESTRONG® Global Cancer Summit in Ireland Announces Call for Irish Volunteers

DUBLIN, Ireland - July 31, 2009 - Today the Lance Armstrong Foundation (LAF) announced a 'Call for Irish Volunteers' to participate in the LIVESTRONG Global Cancer Summit, taking place in Dublin from August 24th - 26th 2009. The LIVESTRONG Global Cancer Summit, the landmark event of the LIVESTRONG Global Cancer Campaign, will be the starting point for sustained worldwide action to combat the cancer burden and will convene world leaders, advocates and representatives from non-profits and corporations.
