Galway based SpamTitan wins another Gold in the March Global Virus Bulletin Anti-spam awards

Galway, March 08, 2010 - SpamTitan has once again achieved a Gold award on its third time to participate in the Virus Bulletin Anti-Spam Test. The Virus Bulletin is an independent global publication specific to the field of viruses and related malware. SpamTitan is the first anti-spam solution that runs on a virtual machine to take part in the Virus Bulletin test, demonstrating that SpamTitan is both an innovative and high quality product.

Virus Bulletin's Anti-spam Test Director Martijn Grooten said that SpamTitans participation 'resulted in another impressive final score, putting the product firmly in position as one of this month's top five performers'.
